BB lives on the same zone as I do. He previously has accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and personal Savior. He has not been baptized. He states that he comes from a family with strong religious involvement by his grandmother, mother and sisters.

BB has two young children, ages 10 and 13. He says that these children go to Bible study at their church.

BB is planning to get married while in prison.

BB plans to get baptized when he gets out of prison. I told him that baptism is only the initiation rite for the Christian church. I made the comparison that, since the prison rules require all prisoners to wear a state shirt before leaving their housing units, and it is a good idea to put-on a state shirt before going out to work: since baptism is the initiation rite for Church membership, it is a good idea to get initiated.

I asked BB, "If you died tonight, where would you spend eternity?"

He said that he believes he will go to heaven.

I asked him, "Do you believe this because of you faith or because of your behavior?"

He said that he bases his statement on both his faith and his behavior.

I told him that his salvation is dependent solely on his faith.
