## GUILTY OR NOT GUILTY?

All of us in prison have had to answer this very question, haven't we? Before anyone is convicted of a crime they have the option of pleading Guilty or Not Guilty. Even if we knew we were guilty "as sin", we could say, "Not guilty your honor?" Well, when the entire world stands before God, who is the true Judge, we will not have this option! The evidence will already be in, and the verdict pronounced. Guilty or Not Guilty!

Friend, do you know today, right now, what God would determine about you? If you died in prison today, or if the Lord Jesus returned today, what would God have to say about your fate? Would you be pronounced Guilty or Not Guilty?

## What makes us Guilty?

The Crime that everyone has committed is called sin. Sin makes us Guilty. Sin is merely being disobedient towards God, breaking one of his Laws which He has set for man to follow. The Bible say's in

(Rom. 3: 23), *"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"*

This means that sin is something all have done and are guilty of. Now I know you may be thinking, "Well I'm not a bad person, I do the best I can, surely God will not find me guilty, will He"? I thought the same thing at one time until I found out what God said in His word about a persons' own righteousness (good deeds).

In *Isaiah 64:6* it reads,

"For all have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment."

See there is nothing of our own, no good deed, no good enough life style in the world to make us right and innocent of sin in God's eyes. But there is a way! There is one way to be proclaimed Not Guilty

## What makes us Not Guilty?

The way is Jesus! (Jn.14:6) The only thing that makes us Not Guilty is the shed blood of Jesus Christ. Jesus sacrificed His own life so that by and through Him we could have the forgiveness of sins and eternal life.

You might be asking yourself, "How did another guy dying for me over 2000 years ago make available the forgiveness of my sins?" The answer is this: God said, "... without the shedding of blood there is no remission (forgiveness) of sins." (Heb.9:22) It is also written in the bible that, "In Him (Jesus) we have the redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses (sins)." (Eph.1:7)

See, friend, unlike us, Jesus was sinless, and because of this He could and did offer Himself as a living sacrifice on our part. Through Jesus' shed blood the sins of all who will believe in Him and make Him their Lord and Savior are forgiven from the penalty of sin, which is (spiritual) death. (Rom.5:9; Rom.6:23) This is called God's grace (receiving from God what we don't deserve) and God's mercy (not getting what we do deserve). By faith you can receive this for yourself and be Not Guilty before God. Wouldn't that be nice?
